Most people will use a touch-tone telephone to make their recordings but we also provide worldwide access to the service through VoIP. Once you have made a recording and have published it, a newsfeed is immediately and automatically updated to alert subscribers to your channel. Free, pro, or premium versions available. How Do I Get Started?

- Create a channel
- Visit your My Account page and create a new channel. Make note of your channel number and password.

1. Add your title - Welcome
2. Short Description - Purpose of gabcast
3. Channel Password - Must be a number
4. Channel Conference Password - Leave blank
5. Category - From drop downlist
6. Keyword - Describes your gabcast
7. Channel Website - optional
8. Explicit - I hope not
9. Disable Comments - I Did
10. Channel Image - Browse for appropriate one.
11. Enable channel locking - I didn't
12. Add new blog - I didn't

Other tips:

- For each question or topic you should create a new channel. It makes it much easier to sort.
- The audio clips can be subscribed to as part of an iTunes podcast.
